CODE OF CONDUCT

WHAT WE EXPECT FROM OUR PUPILS

Attendance & Engagement

- Pupils are expected to attend regularly and take part in lessons.

Behaviour & Respect

- Maintain behaviour that supports a positive, distraction-free learning environment.
- Show respect to everyone in the centre.
- Zero tolerance for abusive language, including racist, homophobic, or gender-based abuse.

Property & Environment

- Respect all school property and equipment.
- Use appropriate language at all times.

Prohibited Items & Substance Use

- No chewing gum is allowed.
- No drugs, alcohol, cigarettes, or vapes on site or used before attending.
- The centre is strictly non-smoking.
- No items that could be considered weapons under any circumstances.
- Electric Scooters and Mopeds are not permitted on site.

Arrival Routine

- Pupils must arrive by 8.45am. Form time is 8.55am - 9.15am. Arrival after 9.15am will be classed as a 'Late' mark in attendance registers.
- Mobile phones must be handed in on arrival.
- Belongings (bags, coats, PE kit) must be stored in lockers.

Uniform Expectations

- Pupils must wear the required uniform:
 - Trousers (provided by parents/carers)
 - Rivers polo shirts and sweatshirt (provided at induction)
