Maths

- **Number fluency** We will focus on counting on and back in ones, tens and hundreds and look at subtraction fact families and applying the inverse.
- Number We will also look at written addition and subtraction methods
- Shape children will discuss properties of 3d shapes and practice drawing (2d perimeters) and building 3d shapes. We will also look at angles and symmetry.

Safety

- Children will be made aware of the dangers of social networking
- We will teach children how to cross a road unsupervised

English

Writing—children will be encouraged to write a range of sentence types by using ca range of conjunctions

Handwriting—increase the legibility, consistency and quality of their handwriting with a focus on ascenders and descenders

Reading—we will work on developing children's interest in reading and encouraging them to think about deliberate word and phrase choices used to capture the readers interest.

Vocabulary—we will develop our emotional vocabulary through daily word Aware sessions as well as building understanding of new and more powerful words

Grammar— we will look at the use of the forms a or an according to whether the next word begins with a consonant or a vowel [for example, a rock, an open box

Spoken language—listen and respond appropriately to adults and their peers

Self care

- We will teach children map skills
- We will show children how to cook with support

Citizenship

- We will focus on learning to cooperate to solve problems in a team
- We will take part in a community improvement project – raise money for charity

Tolerance

- We will teach children to be aware of issues around gender, race. Religion, age, culture and sexual orientation
- We will help children to respect differences of opinion

Topic

Science – Children will be taught that humans and some animals have skeletons. They will name the bones in the human body and make their own skeletons for Halloween. During our study of the festival of light we will consider how shadows are formed

DT — We will also be cooking bread for Harvest and children will be following a recipe and thinking about where the ingredients come from

Geography— we will teach children to name and locate the continents of the World and identify locations of Countries important to them as well as those discussed during different festivals e.g. USA and India

RE— we will reflect on how celebrations and key moments in life are marked within different religions

Art— we will practice mixing colours to match those of the natural world and make as many tones of one colour using only primary colours and white.

PE—Our focus will be taking part in a range of team invasion games and recognising how developing individual skills can improve performance in team games

Computing— We will look at keeping safe online and focus on strategic searching online
