## Uniform



Children attending the Phoenix Centre should wear their mainstream school's uniform and adhere to that uniform policy unless previously agreed with centre staff.

We encourage our children to change into soft slipper socks on arrival which we will provide for each child. Wellies will also be useful for our Forest School sessions

We access the outdoor environment every day, so please ensure your child has appropriate outdoor clothing e.g. coat, sun hat etc.



## Food and Drink



In line with our nurturing ethos all children will be offered snacks and a lunch time meal. We would rather children didn't bring in items from home unless they have previously agreed this with the Centre.

Part of our curriculum is preparation of food and snacks and all children take part in this activity on a regular basis. We will endeavour to provide healthy balanced options each day as well as hot and cold drinks.

Please ensure we are notified of any allergies or intolerances.

## Keeping in touch

Communication between home and school is essential, our staff are always on hand to discuss any queries or concerns you have. Your child will have a named key worker, but please feel free to talk to any member of centre staff. We will have regular 6 week reviews of progress and we encourage your input in these meetings.
