

Maths

- **Number fluency**— We will be ensuring that children can subitize numbers up to 5 and identify number bonds up to 5 (including subtraction) moving on to some bonds to 10
- **Numerical patterns**—children will rehearse verbally counting beyond 20, recognizing the pattern in the counting system
- **Shape**— children will name 2d and 3d shapes and discuss their properties

Safety

- Children will be taught their home address
- Children will know the role of the police, doctors, fire and ambulance services

English

Writing—children will independently write their names. They will work on writing labels and lists. We will also look at forming sentences orally.

Handwriting—children will learn to form lower-case letters in the correct direction, starting and finishing in the right place

Reading—we will work on phase 2/3 phonic sounds so children can apply their knowledge and skills as a route to decode words. We will develop our segmenting skills

Vocabulary—we will focus on develop our emotional vocabulary through daily word Aware sessions

Spoken language—listen and respond appropriately to adults and their peers

Self care

- We will teach children how to post a letter
- We will show children how to clean their teeth
- We will teach children how to put shoes on the right feet

Topic
