Times of the Day



Little Rivers is open for children from 9:30am to 2:00pm, Monday to Friday. The times that your child attends Little Rivers may vary depending on their individual needs.

Parking is available in the visitors section of the car park. Please bring children to the main entrance gate where a member of staff will greet you.

If your child is not attending due to illness or medical appointments, please telephone the main office by 9:30am on the day of absence.

You will be updated with key dates and information via the Little Rivers calendar, Newsletter or letters from us throughout the year. INSET days may vary from your child's mainstream primary school.



Uniform & Personal Belongings



Children attending Little Rivers should wear the Little Rivers school uniform provided.

Children can change into soft slipper socks on arrival which need to be provided from home.

We access the outdoor environment every day, so please ensure your child has appropriate outdoor clothing e.g. coat, sun hat, etc.

Please note that pupils are **not** to bring any personal belongings such as toys, jewellery, etc into Little Rivers, however they are welcome to bring in an item on Fridays if they would like to present it during Show and Tell. Children will have a reading book sent home with them every day.



Food and Drink



In line with our nurturing ethos all children will be offered snacks and a lunch time meal. We would rather children didn't bring in items from home unless they have previously agreed this with Little Rivers.

Part of our curriculum is preparation of food and snacks and all children take part in this activity on a regular basis. We will endeavour to provide healthy balanced options each day as well as hot and cold drinks.
